Hilary Tjapaltjarri was born at Mintjilpirri, to the South-East of Kintore in approximately 1941. After working as a stockman for many years he commenced painting in 1985. In 1999 Hilary contributed to the Kintore men's painting as part of the Western Desert Dialysis Appeal. He lived most of his later life in Haast's Bluff. Hilary died in 2017.
