Tamayinya was still young when his family group came out of the desert into Kiwirrkurra in 1984, making national headlines as the 'last' of the desert nomads to make 'first contact' Prior to this they had been living at Marawa, on the south western side of Lake Mackay. It was estimated at the time of arriving at Kiwirrkura that he was 15 years old. Tamayinya completed his first paintings for Papunya Tula Artists in 1987. He is the brother of Yalti and Yukultji Napangati.
